that campus officials from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign visited HWC on March 31, 2008 as a part of the Transfer Experience and Advising Mentors (TEAM) Project. UIUC recently received a \$900K grant from the Lumina Foundation to recruit community college students, and HWC is one of the schools chosen to partner in this endeavor, which is locally managed by Dr. Barrington Edwards, Associate Dean of Instruction and Rosalind Harris, Part-time Director of the Transfer Center; and

that UIUC representatives were: Dr. Ruth Watkins, Vice Provost; Emanuel Coker, admissions counselor; Dan Cullen, assistant director of admissions; and Keith Marshall, Associate Provost of Enrollment Management; and

that the goals are to: expand the institutional relationship between UIUC and HWC, develop deliverables going forward, and establish timelines for accomplishing goals; and

that the day-long working meetings resulted in the establishment of strategies and targets to recruit HWC students; and

that 17 seventeen administrators and faculty attended the meetings.
