that proposals, contracts, and other special funding instruments are under development or have been submitted by staff at this time.

NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Grow Your Own Teachers (PD# 080501)

Illinois State University has been funded by the Illinois State Board of Education for a project to help communities train and retain teachers for local schools. The grant, for \$169,999 includes a subcontract for Malcolm X College, of \$71,344, to pay for a coordinator, tuition, and tutors. The performance period for this project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

Transitional Allied Health Educational Partnership (PD# 080504)

Olive-Harvey College has been funded for \$7,400 as a subcontract of an award to Chicago State University from the Illinois Board of Higher Education. The funding will support a coordinator and some tutors for the project. The performance period for this award is from October 2, 2007 through October 31, 2008.

City Science TV Series (PD# 080505)

The District Office has submitted a proposal to the Environmental Protection Agency for grant for \$45,000 to support the three pilot episodes of a public television series on science issues for school children, their teachers and their families. The performance period for this project is from February 1, 2008 through January 31, 2010.

Workplace Skills Enhancement Project (PD# 080506)

The Business and Industry Services Department of Wright College has received funding of \$16,520 from the Illinois Secretary of State's Office to provide training in Workplace English as a Second Language for employees of the Freedman Seating Company, Spectra Merchandising, International and the Eli's Cheesecake Company. The performance period for the project is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

AMENDMENTS

Head Start Support Services Program (PD# 080502)

The City of Chicago, Department of Human Services has extended their award to Harold Washington College and increased the maximum funded amount to \$1,688,668 (which includes additional funding of \$398,331) to provide Head Start Supportive Services, including support for the Teacher Assistant Program, the AA-Early Childhood Program, the AA-Social Services Program, the Child Development Associate Program for Family Child Care Home Providers and the Child Development Associate Program for Center-Based Head Start. The performance period for this funding is extended for the one year period from December 1, 2007 through November 30, 2008.

TCF Bank Scholarships(PD# 080503)

TCF Bank has provided \$20,000 to Harold Washington College to be used for scholarships for students enrolled in the Harold Washington College Youth Worker Program. The funds will be available for tuition scholarships beginning with the Fall, 2008 semester.
