REPORTS that on Friday, March 28, 2008 the Adult Education Program in partnership with Women Employed held a one-day *Career Coach Workshop* for the Adult Education students. The purpose of the workshop was to help students begin developing a career that meets their interests, values, and lifestyle needs.
