REPORTS that Truman College launched a new recruitment activity for Adult Education ESL and GED students entitled College 101; and

that the program is designed to provide much-needed general college information, as a complement to the Incentive Program, a merit award program in which upper-level ESL and GED students may qualify for some college credit courses tuition-free; and

that College 101, a joint activity of the Adult Education, Admissions and Advising, Continuing Education, and Financial Aid departments, features an introduction by an Adult Education transition liaison, information from Continuing Education on occupational and personal enrichment courses, an overview of the Credit Program, and a presentation on financial aid; and

that from March 31 through April 5, five College 101 sessions were held with a total of 385 ESL and GED students in attendance.
