# Training Subcontract Agreement Truman College

### THE CHANCELLOR

#### REPORTS

that Truman College secured an agreement with All Products Automotive to provide an Implementation and Coaching Project Program (A maximum of 10 Hours of Instruction), among others, to 11 employees in the amount of \$1,500.00 for the period of 07-29-08 to 07-29-09, and with Precision Plating, Co. to provide a Management Training Program – 2 Groups (A maximum of 28 Hours of Instruction per Group), among others, to 8 employees (per group) in the amount of \$136,330.00 for the period of 06-05-08 to 06-05-09 (CCC Legal fully executed contract on 07-16-08, Board Report # 28864); and

that these training agreements are funded through the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development (MOWD) Tax Increment Funding program; and

that there is a need to enter into a sub-contractor agreement with Smedinghoff Consulting Group, under the MOWD Grant, to provide training to the employees of All Products Automotive and Precision Plating, Co for an amount not to exceed \$5,450.00 and;

that in Fiscal Year 2009 an agreement was executed for Smedinghoff to provide training in the amount of \$5,400 and the addition of \$5,450.00 will exceed \$10,000, and approval is requested for the additional amount of \$5,450.00; and

that this professional service agreement for training is exempt from the District's competitive bidding procedures; and

that the Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced training subcontract agreements and has determined that because All Products Automotive and Precision Plating Co. selected Smedinghoff Consulting Group and since there are no certified MBE or WBE vendors with the ability to provide the prescribed services, it is recommended that a waiver from compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan be granted.

#### RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to enter into a sub-contractual agreement with Smedinghoff Consulting Group to provide training to the employees of All Products Automotive and Precision Plating, Co. for an amount not to exceed \$5,450.00 from 10-16-08 to 07-29-09.
