that Gallery 37 Center for the Arts Advanced Arts Education Program (AAEP) located at 66 East Randolph, Chicago IL. 60601, and the Board of Trustees of Community College District #508 (CCC) a degree granting institution located in Illinois, hereby join in an articulation agreement designed to enhance the educational opportunities available to their respective students. Specifically, the agreement herein is intended to expand the options for those students choosing to transfer to Washburne Culinary Institute (WCI) and complete an Associates Degree; and

that Washburne Culinary Institute (WCI) has been contracted to support this organizations mission for its program by providing professional experience and expertise in the form of instruction and curriculum and the students will be assessed using the same outcomes, Washburne Culinary Institute (WCI) is confident in granting Advanced Standing to graduates of this program that wish to continue their education by offering a total of nine (9) credits distributed over the following courses. Washburne Culinary Institute (WCI) will actively monitor the program to ensure that the material is covered and in line with the outcomes for the following courses:

CUL 701 – Introduction to Foodservice	3 credit	45 contact hours
CUL 703 – Sanitation & Safety I	2 credit	60 contact hours
CUL 704 - Sanitation II	4 credit	60 contact hours

that the Agreement shall commence October 1, 2008 and continue throughout the 2008-2009 Academic Year, renewable each successive academic year.
