THE CHANCELLOR

that the Wilbur Wright College, Department of Environmental Technology (ETP) will provide Health, Safety and Environmental training for the City of Chicago Department of Environment (CDOE) on an as needed basis. This Service will satisfy training requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and other federal, state and local training requirements. Among topics to be included in this training are hazard communication, transportation safety, emergency response training and hazardous materials management topics. This training will be conducted by instructors with appropriate expertise about the topics to be covered.

This training will be arranged based on requests from the CDOE. The length of the training will be based on the regulatory requirements and the needs of the CDOE.

The Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to enter an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Chicago Department of Environment so that the Environmental Technology Program at Wilbur Wright College can provide training.
