NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Community Service Grant (PD# 080101)

WYCC-TV has received notification of anticipated funding of \$847,458, for the Television Community Service Grant from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. This grant supports the basic operation of WYCC-TV and the performance period for the grant project is from October 1, 2007 until September 30, 2009.

Interconnection Grant (PD# 080102)

WYCC-TV has received notification of anticipated funding of \$17,777 for the Interconnection Grant from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. This grant supports the basic operation of WYCC-TV and the performance period for the grant project is from October 1, 2007 until September 30, 2008.

Truman Environmental Intervention Project (PD# 080103)

Truman College has submitted a proposal to SENCER, Inc for a grant of \$3,000 for a project to involve biology and social science students in an examination of environmental risks to public health from diesel exhaust and heavy metal pollutants. The performance period for this project is from August 1, 2007 through August 30, 2008.

21st. Century Community Learning Centers (PD# 080104)

Northeastern Illinois University is awarding a subcontract of \$98,715 to Truman College to support after-school and Saturday programs serving Senn High School students. The prime award was issued by the Illinois State Board of Education and the performance period for the first year of this project is from December 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
