THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that there is a need to enhance the capabilities of faculty to become more effective Chicago Public Schools (hereafter, CPS) teachers and facilitators through the means of professional development in the area of active learning, collaborative learning, code-switching, lesson planning, and assessment; and

that for the purposes of the Project Align grant there is a need to train CPS faculty in the aforesaid methods; and

that City Colleges of Chicago proposes to provide said training to CPS faculty; and

that the training will be divided into three phases: workshops, assessments, and monitoring; and

that participating CPS faculty will receive remuneration for participating and collaborating in the Project Align professional development effort;

that the estimated cost for the expected 28 to 40 participants to receive between 14 and 26 hours of professional development to be provided from January 25, 2008 through July 1, 2008 will not exceed \$41,000; and

that monies encumbered for this activity are a part of a HECA Grant awarded to City Colleges of Chicago from the State of Illinois; and

that this procurement of professional services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above professional services agreement and has determined that since the all of the training associated with the Project Align grant will be provided by in-house City Colleges of Chicago trainers and will not be subcontracting these services with external vendors, therefore, it has been determined that this project does not require compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to enter into an agreement with Chicago Public Schools in an amount not to exceed \$41,000 for City Colleges of Chicago from January 25, 2008 through July 1, 2008.
