NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Commonwealth Edison Regulatory Commitment to CCC (PD# 080301)

As a result of a settlement with ComEd, the City of Chicago has awarded the City Colleges of Chicago a total of \$350,000, of which at least \$250,000 must be spent on energy efficiency improvements. This funding was a result of a settlement agreement between the City of Chicago, its sister agencies and ComEd which resolves litigation between the City of Chicago, certain sister agencies and ComEd. The performance period for this funding is December 1, 2007 through May 31, 2010.

Chicago Housing Authority (PD# 080303)

The Chicago Housing Authority has issued a grant, via an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the District, to provide \$1,000,000 of funding for a project which provides educational services for CHA residents. This project will extend the services which the District is already providing through previous agreements. The performance period for this funding is January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.

Nurse Educator Fellowship (PD# 080304)

The Illinois Board of Higher Education has awarded a grant of \$10,000 to Truman College to be used as a fellowship to supplement the salary of one faculty member, Rashidah Abdullah. The period of performance for this funding is from December 4, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

After School Matters (PD# 080305)

Kennedy King College has submitted a proposal for \$189,916 to the Chicago Department of Children and Youth Services to support pre-apprentice and apprentice programs in the areas of art/theater design, graphics, automotive and career development. This program will be targeted at high school students. The performance period for this project is from June 23, 2008 through August 15, 2008.

GIFTS OR DONATIONS

Construction Materials (PD# 080302)

Saint-Gobain Abrasives, Inc. has donated equipment, valued at approximately \$645.00, to Wright College. The equipment includes calipers, paint bore gages and micrometers.
