**REPORTS** that, Richard J. Daley College is featured in the Chicago Federation of Labor (CFL), Worker Assistance Committee, Annual Report 2007-2008 as a key partner in serving the needs of the Chicago area workforce. The measurable success of the Critical Skills Shortage Initiative (CSSI) program partnership was highlighted as a major accomplishment by the Chicago Federation of Labor. This partnership included Richard J. Daley College, the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development, the CFL Workers Assistance Committee, the Southeast Chicago Development Commission and Central States SER-Jobs for Progress.

that, as the sole training provider, Richard J. Daley College provided job training in Computerized Numerical Control (CNC) Machining and Welding to 73 unemployed workers. The training program concluded with 80% of the workers placed in jobs at livable wages.

that, Ms. Jean Johnson, Dean of Continuing Education for Richard J. Daley College and the Arturo Velasquez West Side Technical Institute, provided the leadership for this partnership.

that, as part of Richard J. Daley College's proactive outreach to the city of Chicago, the Division of Continuing Education establishes partnerships with business, industry and labor. In this way, job seekers and dislocated workers are informed about the workforce training and academic opportunities provided by Richard J. Daley College and the Arturo Velasquez West Side Technical Institute.
