REPORTS

that the City Colleges of Chicago has worked with the Illinois Education Foundation (IEF), a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization, (and its predecessor, the Daniel M. Kerrane, Jr. Foundation) since its inception in the Summer 2004; and

that the IEF has since December 1, 2005 occupied office space at the district office for purposes of administering their scholarship programs and related services; and

that since the Fall 2005 semester, eighty-six CCC students from across all seven City Colleges of Chicago have received IEF and/or Kerrane scholarships, including direct scholarship payments totaling \$160,000 and related support services (tutoring, mentorship, team activities & seminars, and academic and personal advice and support) totaling \$600,000; and

that thirteen former CCC students and IEF/DMK Scholars have graduated from CCC colleges and are currently continuing their education at a 4-year college or university, with continuing IEF support, while thirteen former CCC students and IEF/DMK Scholars have graduated from CCC colleges and have entered the workforce; and

that the IEF provides its scholarship programs for the benefit of CCC students as well as for students at community colleges and 4-year universities across the State of Illinois; and

that a proposed new Facilities Use Agreement would call for the IEF to pay CCC \$500 in monthly rental fees, provide scholarships and related services totaling at least \$100,000 for at least twenty (20) CCC students each year over the initial term of the agreement (approximately \$5.20 per sq ft for rental fees or \$92 per sq ft including scholarship services), and that IEF would pay for its own telecommunications and network facilities, while CCC would pay for normal operating costs of the building space; and

that the proposed initial term of the agreement is July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2014, followed by two (2) year extensions.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS that the Board of Trustees approve a new Facilities Use Agreement for the IEF with an initial 5 year term beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2014 and in which the IEF will pay \$500 per month for a total of \$30,000 in rental fees and will provide at least \$500,000 in scholarships and related services for at least eighty (80) CCC students and graduates, and authorize the Chairman to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Board.

FINANCIAL Revenue - Education Fund 00003 461310 Space Rental Account

CCC will receive \$30,000 in rental fees during the initial term of the agreement (to be credited to the district office building maintenance account) plus a minimum \$500,000 in scholarships and related services for at least eighty (80) CCC students and graduates.
