# INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS EXTENSION AND THE WILBUR WRIGHT COLLEGE ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

### THE CHANCELLOR

#### REPORTS

that the Wilbur Wright College Environmental Technology Program ("ETP") desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Illinois Extension ("Extension"). A previous agreement was approved by the Board in May 2008 and is detailed in Board Report #28686. The Extension will provide additional consultation services for program development for a course of study in Urban Agriculture as part of the Tech Prep initiative for ETP. This project includes curriculum design along with developing cooperative activities with the Chicago High School for Agricultural Sciences and Eli's Cheesecake. Included in this is the development of a career path model for high school dual credit/dual enrollment students interested in pursuing areas of study towards a degree in agricultural fields. The deliverables will include revised syllabi and curriculum materials, career path documentation and classroom materials for students; and

that the term of the intergovernmental agreement will begin on June 7, 2009, and conclude on August 30, 2009; and

that the Board will pay the Extension \$9,500 for its services split between FY2009 and 2010. The funding for this intergovernmental agreement comes from a Community College Tech Prep Support Grant (PD# 071202, Board Report Number 28416) and due to a previous payment this fiscal year total payments to the Extension will exceed \$10,000; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced intergovernmental agreement and, a waiver from compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan has been requested, is recommending that this request be granted.

#### THE CHANCELLOR

**RECOMMENDS** that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Illinois Extension, stating the terms and conditions whereby the Extension agrees to provide consultation services for the development of an Urban Agriculture dual credit/dual enrollment course of study for the Wilbur Wright College Environmental Technology Program, beginning June 7, 2009 and ending August 30, 2009, for a total fee of \$9,500.
