that the Workforce Institute at Harold Washington College worked with the Department of Business and Procurement Services to issue a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) NU0903, public notice for trainers and consultants to provide services on an as needed basis for Training Services in the following categories: Leadership & Management; Workplace Safety & OSHA; Basic Skill (Reading, Writing); IT & Computer Applications (MS Excel & MS Project); Construction; Transportation, Distribution and Logistics; Process Improvement; Languages; Manufacturing; Banking & Financial; Hospitality; Healthcare; Sales & Marketing; Professional Development; Green Technology; Nonprofit; Industrial Maintenance; for Consulting Services in the following categories: Training Project Management; Development; Field IT support; Instructional & Curriculum Design; Grant Writing; Graphic Design; Marketing; Client System Design; Implementation; and

that forty-four (44) vendors submitted qualifying proposals with qualifications, experience, staff, licensing and references and;

that the forty-four (44) vendor submittals were reviewed by staff from the Work Force Institute, Harold Washington College, Dawson Technical, Truman College and Academic Affairs; and

that the evaluation committee is recommending that the 40 vendors with an average score of 300 and above be included on the pre-qualified vendors list which is attached to the report; and

that these firms will be pre-qualified initially for three (3) years with two (2) additional one (1) year extension options; and

that as training projects are identified, the Workforce Institute at Harold Washington College will provide a detailed scope of services to the firms listed in their area of expertise to receive detailed pricing, including any reimbursable expenses; and

that the Workforce Institute at Harold Washington College will evaluate and select the lowest responsive bidder for the specified project ; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the submittals referenced above for the Workforce Institute and, while there are certified M/WBE consultants identified as specific trainers, that the Participation Plan will be reviewed per project for compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

that the Board of Trustees approves the list of firms and authorizes these firms to respond to solicitations for work for an initial period of three (3) years and a subsequent renewal period of two (2) additional one (1) year extension options.
