**REPORTS**

that in Board Report # 29013, dated October 2, 2008, the Board of Trustees renewed an agreement for a period of one year with the Oracle Corporation for maintenance services on the PeopleSoft Human Resource, Student Administration and Financial system modules from October 30, 2008 through October 29, 2009; and

that the Oracle Corporation has proposed to provide the necessary software updates and maintenance services on the above software modules for the period of November 1, 2009 through October 31, 2010, at a total cost of \$699,557.66; and

that in Board Report# 29013, dated October 2, 2008, the Board of Trustees renewed an agreement for a period of one year with the Oracle Corporation for maintenance services on the PeopleSoft Contributor Relations, Campus Directory Interface and Portal software from November 6, 2008 through November 5, 2009; and

that the Oracle Corporation has proposed to provide the necessary software updates and maintenance services on the above software modules for the period of November 6, 2009 through November 5, 2010, at a total cost of \$33,417.46; and

that in Board Report# 29013, dated October 2, 2008, the Board of Trustees renewed an agreement for a period of one year with the Oracle Corporation for maintenance services on the PeopleSoft User Productivity Kit module from October 31, 2008 through October 30, 2009; and

that the Oracle Corporation has proposed to provide the necessary software updates and maintenance services on the User Productivity Kit modules for the period of October 31, 2009 through October 30, 2010, at a total cost of \$71,867.52; and

that OIT staff has determined that the proposals from Oracle which include a cost increase of three percent from the previous year are reasonable and acceptable, and recommends renewal of the software support and maintenance service agreements for the periods indicated above; and

that this procurement of software maintenance services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above renewal for a proprietary system and, there are no certified M/WBE firms that can provide the required software updates or maintenance services and Oracle Corporation is continuing to work indirectly with M/WBE partners on other projects in compliance with the Board Approved Participation plan.

that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to approve agreement renewals in the total amount not to exceed \$804,842.64 with the Oracle Corporation to provide software upgrades and maintenance services for the PeopleSoft Human Resource, Student Administration and Financial system modules beginning October 30, 2009 through October 29, 2010, for PeopleSoft Contributor Relations, Campus Directory Interface and Portal software from November 6, 2009 through November 5, 2010 and for the PeopleSoft User Productivity Kit modules from October 31, 2009 through October 30, 2010.
