NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS (Total Value - \$ 239,936.36)

Cooperative Work Study (PD# 090401)

Wright College has received funding of \$18,150 from the Illinois Board of Higher Education to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from Jan 27, 2009 until June 30, 2010.

Cooperative Work Study (PD# 090402)

Harold Washington College has received funding of \$24,969 from the Illinois Board of Higher Education to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from Jan 27, 2009 until June 30, 2010.

Grow Your Own Consortium (PD# 090403)

Malcolm X College has received a subaward of \$66,411 from Illinois State University for a project that will encourage and support students to become candidates for elementary school teaching positions. The projects pays for tutors, textbooks and tuition. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

Empowering Community College Students to Become Scientists (PD# 090404)

Wright College has received an award of \$2,000 from the Delta Kappa Gamma Educational Foundation of Texas to support a research mentoring program for biology students at the College. The performance period for this project is from June 1, 2009 through June 15, 2010.

Summerfest Seminar for Outdoor Festival Vendors (PD# 090405)

Harold Washington College has received an award of \$7,500 to train Chicago Park District personnel on how to handle food safely in an outdoor environment. The performance period for this training is from May 20, 2009 through May 27, 2009. Funds paid to Harold Washington College are tuition charges at \$30.00 per participant for each of four, three hour sessions for a total of 250 participants.

The TSA Agreement (PD# 090406)

Wright College has received an award from the of up to \$120,906.36 from the American Association of Community Colleges using Homeland Security funding to train up to 24 airline personnel in self-defense skills. The performance period for this project is from January 1, 2009 through December 30, 2009.
