that evaluators for the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC) will recommend that the Nursing Program be given a full eight-year accreditation with an interim report in two years addressing criteria 6.1 and 6.2 regarding systematic evaluation plan and student learning outcomes assessment; and

that evaluators Anna Moore and Barbara Wilford, who spent two and a half days at Truman, were impressed by the professionalism and skill of Nursing Director Vickie Gukenberger and the faculty, with Nursing's seamlessly "threaded" curriculum, with the department's use of technology, and with students' skill levels, particularly their 95- to 100-percent pass rate on the national nursing licensing exam, nearly 10 points above national and Illinois averages.
