that on November 21, 2008 Wilbur Wright College's Office of Student Activities in cooperation with the Cook County Sheriff's Office held a Drunk Driver Prevention Seminar. The seminar was open to the Wright College student body and to the community at large. Each one hour presentation included a film on the impact of Driving Under the Influence and poster displays on the health effects of alcohol. Approximately 120 individuals participated in the activity, which was featured in the evening FOX Television Newscast.

that the highlight of the event was an activity where participants donned sight impairing goggles and tried to safely drive through an obstacle course in a golf cart. This activity is designed to illustrate the danger of driving under the influence. Not a single "impaired" driver was able to safely negotiate the test course.

that based on the success of this activity, a follow-up event will be held in Spring 2009.
