TO CORRECT BOARD REPORT #29941 DATED JANUARY 7, 2010

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT NO. 508 AND LOCAL 7, NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF FIREMEN AND OILERS

WHEREAS, the Board and the Local 7, National Conference of Firemen and Oilers are parties to a collective bargaining agreement for firemen and oilers, who operate and maintain machinery and equipment for which they are responsible, which expired on June 30, 2009, and

WHEREAS, City Colleges representatives have engaged in good faith collective bargaining with representatives of Local 7 (the Union) as required by law and have reached a tentative agreement effective July 1, 2009 through June 20, 2012 with respect to changes in wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment of the above referenced employees represented by Local 7; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved Resolution 29941 at its January 2010 meeting that misstated the salary increase that the parties negotiated; and

WHEREAS, the agreement provides for a 1.5% increase in wages each year for the next three years and entails no other changes in the wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Board approve the resolution that accurately describes the tentative agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, hereby:

- 1. Approves this corrected resolution approving the tentative agreement reached by the Board representatives and Local 7 as described in this resolution and rescinds Board Report 29941 approved in January 2010; and,
- 2. Authorizes the Chancellor or her designee to submit the collective bargaining agreement for execution by Local 7 and the Board Chairman.
