that on Friday February 19, 2010, Architecture students at Harold Washington College presented their designs for a Green Roof at the college, and;

that more than two dozen students worked on the design, coming in on weekends and before classes began, to put together a presentation for the college Sustainability Committee in room 1115, and;

that the student designs featured a wooden scale model of Harold Washington College and surrounding skyscrapers, and;

that as part of the design process, architecture students did a digital sun analysis of the roof, determined how much rainfall can be expected, calculated wind conditions, studied bird habitats and determined the urban “heat island” effect would be greatly reduced by a green roof, and;

that the students were supervised by Harold Washington College Architecture Instructors John Madsen, Dolores Ochoa, Ivanhoe Tejada and Architecture Tutor Eliza Bober.
