that ComEd donated \$35,000 to the Dawson Technical Institute Overhead Electrical Line Workers Program (DTI-OELWP) during a check presentation ceremony on Friday, March 19, 2010 at Dawson Technical Institute. Students in the ninth DTI-OELWP class scaled 65 foot poles to demonstrate their employment readiness.

that Terry Donnelly, EVP ComEd presented the check and said the job training partnership with DTI “continues to deliver individuals to the workforces who are fully trained for the rigorous and plentiful - electrical line worker jobs.” John Dozier, president, Kennedy-King College said the ComEd partnership meets the City Colleges of Chicago mission to “create pathways to immediate employment and success for students”. The donated funds will be used for vehicle repairs and acquiring supplies to operate the program.
