The Cook County Night Basketball League is a holistic, anti-violence program aimed at youth, ages seventeen (17) to thirty (30). The program offerings include health physicals, medical screenings, counseling, life skills/leadership development, employment training and placement, and registration into Continuing and Adult Education classes.
