# <u>Illinois Home Weatherization Assistance Program Contractor Training (IHWAP) (PD# 100803)</u>

The Illinois Community College Board has awarded \$25,000 to Wright College for training contractors working in or entering into the Illinois Home Weatherization Assistance Program. This funding will actually be provided as a grant from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity via an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Illinois Community College Board.

**Benefit to the City Colleges of Chicago:** This funding will allow the District to provide required training to Chicago contractors so that they will have access to federal funds to support weatherization programs in Chicago.

**Accountability:** Dr. Victoria Cooper, Director of Environmental Technology at Wright College, will serve as Project Director and will assume all fiscal and programmatic responsibility for the project.

**Other Information:** The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. The grant includes funding for training stipends of \$1500 each (plus travel expense reimbursement) for two Wright College staff members, John Porterfield and Cheryl Pomeroy, to attend the DCEO required training during August in Champaign, Illinois.
