### REPORTS

that there is a need to standardize the mail centers throughout the District with a system/process that allows for automatic tracking of deliveries, provides for electronic maintenance of college supply inventories, improves the efficiency of mail receipts and can be the basic framework for the projected expansion to a fully automated mailing system; and

that the District Finance Office of Business and Procurement Services has determined that it is most cost effective to utilize the State of Illinois – CMS contracted vendor Pitney Bowes to provide this type of equipment and software to the City Colleges of Chicago; and

that Pitney Bowes was selected by the State of Illinois on a competitive basis through Solicitation No. 221176 bid open date of April 12, 2007; and

that the District Finance Office of Business and Procurement Services in conjunction with the Office of Administrative Services has received a proposal from Pitney Bowes who currently provides mail equipment and software at two locations which meet the U.S. Postal Service digital requirements and includes a mail shipping processor and electronic scale for District Office, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, Harold Washington College and Wright College; and

that staff is recommending acceptance of the proposal from Pitney Bowes to provide the following items for the District:
