**REPORTS**

that the Illinois Community College Board provided a special grant (PD #100411) to support the instruction to certify the students in Computer refurbishment in the A+ Computer Repair Technician Program (trained through the CIMA partnership) at the Humboldt Park Vocational Education Center of Wright College; and

that Digital Workforce Education Society (DWES) has the ability to provide this training component which includes supplying all equipment, tools, and educational materials necessary for the training of 12 students; and

that the fee for this agreement will be \$19,200 for the five week training period; and

that DWES, an Illinois not-for-profit agency, has the necessary qualifications and experience to complete the technical training of the students and prepare them entry into the workforce; and

that this professional service agreement is exempt from the District's competitive bidding procedures; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced training agreement, and since DWES provides all of the equipment and material required for this training, and since there are no opportunities for certified MBE or WBE direct or indirect participation; it is recommended that a waiver from compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan be granted.

that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to execute a training agreement with Digital Workforce Education Society for the not to exceed amount of \$19,200 from May 17, 2010 through June 25, 2010.
