**PURCHASE OF DENTAL HYGIENE CAMERAS
KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE**

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that there is a need to purchase dental hygiene cameras for the Dental Hygiene Program at Kennedy-King College to enhance experimental learning through the use of intraoral digital cameras; and

that specifications were prepared by District Procurement staff, publicly advertised on March 15, 2010 and emailed to eleven (11) companies. A pre-bid meeting was held on March 22, 2010 and three (3) bids were received as listed below:

Patterson Dental Wood Dale, IL	\$23, 183.00
Henry Schein Dental (a div. of Henry Schein, Inc.) Chicago, IL	\$23,973.00

that the Dental Hygiene Program staff has reviewed the bids submitted and have deemed the bid submitted by Practicon, Inc. as non-responsive since they did not bid as per specifications; and

that staff has determined that it is in the best interest of City Colleges of Chicago to award the bid based on the most responsive and responsible bidder's total bid price, which was submitted by Patterson Dental and has determined that its price is reasonable and acceptable; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced equipment purchase has determined that there are no opportunities for subcontracting with certified M/WBE firms, and is recommending a waiver of compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to approve the issuance of a purchase order to Patterson Dental of Wood Dale, IL in a total amount not to exceed \$23,183.00 to purchase the dental hygiene cameras in accordance with the specifications of Bid #MWJ1004 dated March 15, 2010.
