# ALLIED WASTE TRANSPORATION, INC. /NATIONAL WASTE SERVICES, INC. SELF-CONTAINED COMPACTOR MALCOLM X COLLEGE [RATIFICATION]

### THE CHANCELLOR

**REPORTS** that Malcolm X College is experiencing an increased problem with rodents and the current compactor and its location is insufficient to address the issue; and

that this issue presents an emergency which could result in a serious health hazard to the campus population and its functions; and

that working with Office of Administrative Services and the current pest management vendor, the best possible resolution would be to move the location of a self-contained compactor to the west side of the building and abate the entire east side of the building; and

that Malcolm X needs to have not only a larger compactor but one that is also self contained as at other campuses that will service at least 20-25 cubic yards; and

that the current scavenger service provider for Malcolm X College, Allied Waste Transportation, Inc., can provide and install a 20 cubic yard self-contained compactor at a total cost of \$26,536; and

that the Office of Administrative Services and the Office of Business and Procurement Services found this cost to be reasonable and within industry standards after informally soliciting quotes from three vendors (Allied Waste Transportation, Inc./National Waste Services, Inc., Waste Link Corp. and Chicago Compactors); and

that the pick-up of compactor contents will continue through the District's authorized vendor, Allied Waste Transportation, Inc.; and

that this emergency purchase request is exempt from the District's competitive bidding procedures; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced purchase agreement and, as there are no opportunities for

subcontracting with certified M/WBE firms for this transaction, Allied Waste Transportation, Inc/National Waste Services, Inc, is increasing the participation of West Fuels, Inc., a certified MBE and Linda Construction, Inc., a certified WBE on the District's current scavenger services contract (See Board Report 29813 adopted November 2, 2009) in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan; and

that it shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article II, Section 2.6.4(b) of the Board Rules for Management and Government.

#### THE CHANCELLOR

**RECOMMENDS** that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to ratify the issuance of a purchase order to Allied Waste Transportation, Inc./National Waste Services, Inc in the amount of \$26,536 for purchase of a 20 cubic yard self-contained compactor for Malcolm X College.
