that the final assessment and credentialing of child care providers under this program is through the Council for Professional Recognition which is the only national organization that administers the CDA credential; and

that Harold Washington College seeks Board approval for the issuance of purchase orders for submission of the Direct Assessment Application Fee to the Council for Professional Recognition for thirty-nine students to apply for the CDA credential; and

that the cost for each Direct Assessment Application to the Council for Professional Recognition is \$325 per student and that the total cost will not exceed \$12,675; and

that this sole source credential program is exempt from the District's competitive bidding procedures; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above agreement request and, the Council for Professional Recognition is the sole credentialing organization for the CDA credential and with no opportunities for additional subcontractors is recommending that a waiver of compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan be granted; and

that it shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article II, Section 2.6.4(b) of the Board Rules for Management and Government.
