**REPORTS** that Humanities adjunct Claudia Paraskiv screened two of her experimental black and white films, *Fatigue* and *Ant Farm*, September 22 at the college; and

that *Fatigue* is "a young man's entrapment in his own absurd nightmare, which leads him toward an unexpected escape;" and

that *Ant Farm*, a study of Chicagoans as ants, "unaware of the danger lurking behind them constantly," features Claudia's late husband, Val, a Romanian film actor, writer, and director, and former Truman adjunct; and

that both films were shown during the opening day of the annual Female Eye Film Festival March 24 at the WARC Gallery in Toronto, Canada.
