**Head Men's Coach Garland Dildy Passes
KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE**

that Mr. Garland Dildy, the men's lead basketball coach at Kennedy-King College, died at home Friday, July 30, 2010 after a long battle with kidney problems and lupus. The Kennedy-King College Statesmen enjoyed several winning seasons under the leadership Coach Dildy who became lead coach in 2008 following the untimely death of another legendary coach Mr. Willie Little; and

that Coach Dildy is remembered for his uncompromised and passionate commitment to students succeeding as top athletes and academic high achievers. Mr. Dildy died at age 52. He grew up and lived in South Shore and played on the Mount Carmel high school basketball team; and

that he attended Southern Illinois University and Missouri Valley University. He launched his coaching career as an assistant coach first at Missouri Valley in Marshall, Ill., and later at Waubonsie Valley. He also coached AAU basketball in the early 1990s; and

that from 2000 to 2003, he served as an assistant coach at Kennedy-King College under coach Willie Little. He became lead coach after Coach Little passed away; and

I that in his seven seasons as head coach with Kennedy-King, Mr. Dildy had five 20-win seasons. His overall coaching record was 160 wins and 63 losses.
