NEW PROPOSALS (Total Amount Proposed \$2,091,026)

KKC/Dawson STEPS Program (PD# 100206)

Kennedy-King College has submitted a proposal for \$1,975,563 to the US Dept of Energy for a project that would strengthen the capacity and services of the College by enhancing training for entry-level and incumbent workers pursuing solar/clean energy careers. The performance period for this project is from February 15, 2010 to February 14, 2013.

Collaborative Research: Cultured Economics and Gendered Experiences and Definitions of Work: The Case of Latinas in Chicago and Women in Mexico (PD# 100207)

Wright College has submitted a proposal for \$115,463 to the National Science Foundation, in collaboration with the University of Illinois in Champaign Urbana, for a research project to compare and contrast the economic struggles of Latinas in the US with women in Mexico. The performance period for this award is from June 15, 2010 through June 14, 2012.
