AA	Dominican University General Degree Completion Agreement	The Agreement articulates the policies and procedures for the acceptance of CCC students (who graduate with an Associate Degree from any of the seven campuses) into a Dominican University baccalaureate degree program. Students granted admission to Dominican shall be guaranteed that up to 68 semester hours of credit will be accepted toward a degree.	7/1/11-6/30/12
WR	ACT, Inc. Data Sharing Agreement	The College and ACT will work on research projects that require file sharing of proprietary information. These projects will benefit the College in two ways: (1) By identifying skill areas where students need extra help, WR can then target educational interventions and increase the chances for student success; and (2) By examining relationships between students' level of preparation and subsequent success in specific career programs, the College can then determine what career programs may warrant curricular adjustments to enhance student success.	6/1/11-5/31/14
WR	Illinois Network of Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies (INCCRRA)	The IL Dept. of Human Services funds the Gateways to Opportunity Scholarship Program, which is	7/1/11-6/30/12

	MOU	administered through a contract with the INCCRRA. The INCCRRA provides tuition payments to a maximum 15 credit hours per year for three terms, for approved recipients attending WR. WR agrees to accept a minimum of 55 semester credit hours of transferable coursework earned at the community college level for individuals applying for admission to the university and acceptance in the Early Childhood/Child Development degree program.
