THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to execute the renewal of service agreements with Oracle Corporation to provide software support maintenance services for various Oracle modules during the period beginning July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013 at a cost of \$1,554,217.88.

TERM:

In order to provide for several contracts with Oracle ending at or near the same contract expiration date, the term of each agreement will commence on either July 1, 2011 and end on June 30, 2012 or commence as early as October 31, 2011 and end on June 30, 2013.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Oracle will software support maintenance services to the District for various Oracle modules.

Oracle will perform as follows from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012:

1. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise eCompensation, eProfile and Talent Acquisition Manager software and related modules (Contract Number 2774071)
2. Provide maintenance and support services for Oracle partitioning which enhances the performance, manageability and availability of a wide variety of applications and helps reduce costs for storing large amounts of data (Contract Number 3650674)
3. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise Billing, Receivables and Grants which streamlines the billing process and delivers functionality and flexibility to managing billing and grant activities (Contract Numbers 3666638 and 4569179)
4. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise Portal which offers a complete portal framework for building, deploying and managing portals that are integrated with the Oracle Web Server (Contract Number 3666872)

5. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise Expenses and eProcurement which decentralizes, automates and controls purchasing functions (Contract Numbers 3919914 and 4573206)

Oracle will perform as follows from October 31, 2011 through June 30, 2013:

1. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise User Productivity Kit which provides a comprehensive content development, deployment and maintenance platform for increasing project, program and user productivity through all phases of project lifecycle (Contract Number 2063207)

Oracle will perform as follows from November 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013:

1. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise Finance, HCM (provides assistance in financial management, performance management, succession planning career development and compensation and recruiting tools) and PSSA (assists in management of student services and business operations by building all transactions into common Web pages for easy access from any Web browser) (Contract Number P-98-849-00-000--31)

Oracle will perform as follows from November 6, 2011 through June 30, 2013:

1. Provide maintenance and support services for PeopleSoft Enterprise Campus Directory Interface Enterprise Portal and Contributor Relation which provide students, alumni faculty and staff with immediate access to real-time information (Contract Number P-03-07741-000--11)

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This solution will enable the District office to fulfill software upgrade and maintenance needs in a cost effective fashion.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to State law, purchases and contracts for the use, purchase, delivery, movement or installation software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced software support and maintenance services agreements, and as there are no certified MBE or WBE vendors who can directly provide the software updates and maintenance services needed to run the District's PeopleSoft applications, Oracle does work with certified MBE and WBE firms as part of its commitment to diversity utilization (firms are detailed and on file) and through indirect participation, and therefore, is in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article II, Section 2.6.4(b) of the Board Rules for Management and Government.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board’s Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.
