PURCHASE OF ADULT HUMAN SIMULATOR SYSTEM
MALCOLM X COLLEGE, WRIGHT COLLEGE AND TRUMAN COLLEGE

THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to approve the purchase of an adult human simulator to provide state-of-the-art training equipment and experience for Allied Health Malcolm X College and Wright College students, including those in the nursing, nephrology/renal dialysis, physician assistant and respiratory programs and a system warranty for the adult human simulator currently in use at Truman College for a total amount not to exceed \$135,293.

DESCRIPTION:

Malcolm X College and Wright College request the purchase of the adult human simulator for each college. The adult human simulator includes full body wireless instrumentation, a workstation for five patients, delivery of fourteen (14) clinical experiences and a two-year system warranty. Truman College is requesting a system warranty for adult human simulator it currently uses.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The adult human simulator is the only adult patient simulator that employs multiple models of human physiology, including cardiovascular, pulmonary, neuromuscular and central nervous systems.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

METI Learning is the sole source vendor for the acquisition of the METI Adult Human Emergency Care Simulator. Each capability of the adult human simulator uniquely meets the requirements of the end-user and can only be obtained from METI Learning and its METI Nursing Patient Simulator.

MBE/WBE CONTRACT COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the above request and, METI (Medical Education Technologies Inc.) is the sole owner and manufacturer of a proprietary system currently used by

the District as an instructional tool in the medical programs, providing service, repairs and software upgrades, with no certified MBE or WBE vendors to subcontract to without violation of equipment warranty, therefore, it is recommended that a waiver of direct participation in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan be granted.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General’s authority under Article II, Section 2.6.4(b) of the Board Rules for Management and Government.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board’s Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.
