RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AUTOMOTIVE SERVICES TRAINING AND PRACTICUM INITIATIVE
KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE

WHEREAS, Kennedy-King College desires to create an Automotive Services Training and Practicum Program (Program) from October 3, 2011 through June 30, 2013, that will allow for students in the Automotive Services program to receive direct on the job training, utilizing skills taught in the classroom, in a real garage environment;

WHEREAS, the Program will include service techniques taught in a lab environment that will include diagnostic vehicle inspections, service and repair estimation, minor repairs, oil and filter changes, tire service, grease and lubrication;

WHEREAS, the vehicles that will be a part of this Program are owned by the District and primarily used by Security and engineering staff; Repair Services under the Program will be for non-hybrid or diesel engines;

WHEREAS, the cost of services will be billed to each College unit by Kennedy-King and will be the cost of parts plus 5%, a fee that will be utilized toward the increased cost for pick-up of waste in the District; and

WHEREAS, City Colleges of Chicago is committed to providing opportunities for our students enrolled in the Automotive Studies curriculum, to train and apply classroom applications to an actual task with a real time component while providing the District with a ready source for minor same day service and repairs as a back-up to the existing Fleet Fuel and Service Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees supports and approves the Automotive Services Training and Practicum Initiative at Kennedy-King College.
