THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the execution of a professional services agreement with SGA Youth & Family Services, Chicago, IL to provide counseling and training services to Truman Middle College High School during the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 in the amount of \$58,000.00.

- **USER:** Truman Middle College High School
- **TERM:** The term of the agreement is from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

For the past 21 years, SGA Youth and Family Services (SGA) has provided individual and group counseling services to students. Under this agreement, SGA will supply a part-time Master level licensed clinical social worker who will provide: 1) group and individual counseling to approximately 161 students; 2) clinical training to faculty; 3) consultation with staff and administrators regarding student selection; and 4) consultation with the Truman Middle College High School (TMCHS) Principal.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

SGA's goals are to assist the at-risk student population to cope more adequately with the problems that have developed in their lives, including drop-out behavior and poor academic functioning, to work with parents, to create a positive support system for the students and to consult with staff in building and maintaining a unified learning strategies/behavioral intervention approach. SGA's goals and methods will ultimately assist in the retention of students at the TMCHS so that the students have a higher probability of graduating and functioning more constructively as young adults.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

This purchase of professional services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements. The use of SGA for these services is required by the Youth Connection Charter Schools Grant.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above agreement request and, SGA, providing direct and confidential services to students, will not be subcontracting any part of this agreement. However, SGA does have agreements with certified MBE and WBE firms for other services, including auditing, financial consulting, office cleaning and development design. Therefore, the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance recommends approval of indirect participation in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.
