WHEREAS, new educational programs require approval of the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, and the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB);

WHEREAS, an application for approval of an existing program, Food Service Sanitation/Recertification, short term basic certificate at Kennedy-King College, has been received and has been appropriately reviewed for submission; and

WHEREAS, the Food Service Sanitation Recertification certificate program offers training in food service sanitation in three languages (English, Spanish, Chinese/Cantonese/Mandarin) and prepares personnel from food establishments for "Certification" and "Re-Certification" by the City of Chicago and the State of Illinois. This program also trains and certifies food vendors participating in outdoor summer festivals;
