### TERM:

The agreement will commence on November 1, 2012 and end on May 31, 2013.

### SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Oracle will provide software support maintenance services and extended maintenance service support to the District for various Oracle Modules including: but not limited to Peoplesoft Enterprise, eProcurement-Enterpise, and Peoplesoft Enterprise Accounts.

### **BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:**

This solution will enable the District to fulfill software upgrade and maintenance needs in a cost effective manner.

### **VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:**

Pursuant to State law, purchases and contracts for the use, purchase, delivery, movement or installation of software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

### **MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:**

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced software support and maintenance service agreements, and as there are no certified MBE or WBE vendors that can directly provide the software updates and maintenance services needed to run the District's PeopleSoft applications, Oracle does work with certified MBE and WBE firms as part of its commitment to diversity utilization through indirect participation, and therefore, is in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Inspector General- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
