that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to renew the existing Apple Computer Collegiate Purchase Program Agreement to enable District-wide purchase of Apple products for the period from May 1, 2012 through April 30, 2013, at a total cost not to exceed \$465,000.00.

USER: District-wide

TERM:

The renewal term of the agreement will commence on May 1, 2012 and end on April 30, 2013.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

As described in Board Report 26836 dated July 14, 2005, Apple Computer, Inc. requires that its higher education customers establish eligibility to purchase Apple products at discounted prices through participation in the Apple Computer Collegiate Purchase Program.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Similar to previously approved agreements with Apple Computer, Inc., this solution will authorize CCC to order Apple products on the then-current applicable authorized Apple price list for its own use throughout the District.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to State law, all contracts for the purchase and delivery of data processing equipment, software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above request and, this is an extension of the master agreement with Apple Computer, Inc, as a sole source transaction and with no opportunity to subcontract with certified firms, is recommending that a continuation of the previously approved waiver be granted in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.
