I. REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Chairman Martin Cabrera, Jr., called the meeting to order at 10:03 A.M.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

IV SPEAKERS TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

Mr. Gerald P. Doyle, Vice Provost, Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT), addressed the Board regarding IIT's undergraduate program. At least 60% of City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) students have transferred to IIT. Admission packets were handed out to the Trustees.
