SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Sutton Ford, Inc. will provide a 2013 Ford Utility Police Interceptor All Wheel Drive for use by Daley College as needed for the Office of Safety and Security.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Daley College has determined that there is a need to purchase a new Campus Safety and Security Police Vehicle for use by the Campus Safety and Security to patrol Daley College's facilities. This vehicle is intended to replace a 1996 high mileage Jeep that is currently in poor mechanical and physical condition for use as a security vehicle.
