TERM:

The term commenced on July 1, 2011 and will end on June 30, 2012.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Online database publishing services and learning resources will provide City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) with unlimited access to research databases to enhance their learning experience.

Due to increased usage, increased student enrollment, usage of additional services provided by these vendors, and past due outstanding invoices in the amount of \$14,400.800, additional funds are needed to continue to provide online database publishing services to support CCC students for the balance of FY2012.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Online database publishing services and learning resources provide CCC students with access to

academic databases necessary to further augment, enhance and complete their studies.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to State law, goods which are economically procurable from only one source are exempt

from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced purchase request and as there is no opportunity to further directly subcontract the online services or learning

resources provided by this vendor, it is recommended that a waiver be granted in compliance with

the Board Approved Participation Plan.
