FINANCIAL AID CONSULTING SERVICES PROEDUCATION SOLUTIONS, LLC (AMENDMENT TO BOARD REPORT 31579 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2012) OFFICE OF FINANCE

THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to execute an amendment to the agreement with ProEducation Solutions, LLC, to provide consulting services for financial aid processing. The amendment will exempt them from subcontracting with a certified W/MBE firm given the unique service product provided by Proeducation Solutions, LLC. In prior agreements, ProEd provided the appropriate amount of MBE participation. However, the current agreement given its consulting nature does not lend itself to subcontracting. There is no request for additional funds.

ORIGINAL TERM:

Pursuant to Board Report 31579 adopted on September 13, 2012, the term of the agreement commenced on October 1, 2012 and will end on October 31, 2013.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

ProEducation Solutions, LLC provides comprehensive consulting services in support of the Regent Education software implementation for financial aid processing. The scope of services includes, but is not limited to, the following:

1. Implementation support of the recommendations provided by ProEducation Solutions, LLC based on their previously authorized consulting review of financial aid operations at all seven City Colleges of Chicago and the District Office;

2. Consulting assistance with system design to ensure compliance with applicable federal regulations, optimal service to students, and efficient business process reengineering;

3. Assistance with regression testing and the preparation of test cases for user acceptance testing;

4. Assistance with integrating Regent Education software with federal financial aid processing platforms, including: Common Origination and Disbursement (COD); National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS); Student Aid Internet Gateway (SAIG); and Central Processing System (CPS); and,

5. Staffing augmentation related to the implementation, including, but not limited to, providing back-filling of vacancies created by the project, and providing financial aid processing services through outsourcing as a contingency plan for the project.

At a total cost of \$140,000, the nature of the consulting work the firm is completing for the District is not appropriate for subcontractor involvement due to the high degree of specialization and knowledge of the District's current operations that is required for this project. As a result, a waiver of the minority compliance requirements for ProEducation Solutions given their unique service product and the inefficiency of subcontracting with another party for these services is requested. This waiver was intended to be requested upon execution of the contract.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The services provided by ProEducation Solutions, LLC assist City Colleges of Chicago in implementing Regent Education's financial aid processing software in a way that is compliant with the federal regulations that govern Title IV programs. ProEducation Solutions, LLC is a highly regarded consulting firm that specializes in financial aid operations and is qualified to ensure that decisions made during the Regent Education implementation will result in compliance with federal regulations, standardized and automated financial aid processes, a system that operates efficiently and compliantly, and optimal service to City Colleges of Chicago's financial aid students. The support provided by ProEducation Solutions, LLC in the Regent Education implementation will ensure the compliant and timely delivery of an estimated \$150,000,000 in financial aid revenue per year; \$300,000,000 over a two year period.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to State law, contracts for the services of individuals possessing a high degree of professional skill where the ability or fitness of the individual plays an important part are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements. ProEducation Solutions, LLC was selected to assist with the Regent Education software implementation because they are uniquely qualified due to their in-depth understanding of the financial aid operations at the City Colleges of Chicago. During the month of June 2012, ProEducation Solutions, LLC completed a comprehensive review of financial aid operations at all seven (7) City Colleges of Chicago and

the District Office. The final report of this review, including in-depth recommendations to improve both compliance and service to students, will be delivered by August 31, 2012.

Based upon ProEducation Solutions, LLC's in-depth knowledge of our financial aid operations and financial aid consulting experience with numerous institutions across the country, it is uniquely situated to assist us in implementing best practices in financial aid as well as move us toward complete regulatory compliance in a manner that aligns with City Colleges of Chicago's current operations and its goals for Reinvention.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the amendment request and ProEducation Solutions, LLC, has no opportunity for subcontracting. Therefore, the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance recommends granting a waiver to be in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
