**THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:**

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to amend the existing agreement with Assessment Technologies Institute, LLC to provide the Virtual ATI-NCLEX Review for 2013 City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) graduating nursing students for the period from April 4, 2013 through August 15, 2013, at a total cost not to exceed \$100,000.

**TERM:** The term will commence on April 4, 2013 and end on August 15, 2013.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

The Assessment Technologies Institute, LLC (ATI) Virtual-ATI NCLEX Review provides an innovative, online partnership which prepares nursing graduates for NCLEX success. The review directly aligns with the current NCLEX test plan. Through collaboration with a virtual coach, students are engaged in a personalized, assessment-driven NCLEX review in an online classroom that provides students access to a variety of on-demand resources. Students receive feedback and encouragement from their own personal online coach. The Virtual-ATI NCLEX Review includes the following:

- Students are assigned a coach who is a Masters-prepared nurse educator with at least five years of teaching experience
- Online practice assessments including 500+ questions with rationales for correct/incorrect answers
- Detailed diagnostic reports that are generated immediately after an individual practice assessment is taken
- A Comprehensive Predictor Exam for students to take at the completion of the review

- On-demand classroom features with 250+ online learning activities, links that support learning, a NCLEX Question of the Day and an online virtual bookshelf
- Student review materials in both print and video formats
- Weekly progress reports for institutions purchasing Virtual-ATI NCLEX Review for their students

**BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:**

The CCC Nursing Program Executive Director, Nursing Directors and Nursing Faculty have determined that the Virtual-ATI NCLEX Review will provide the nursing students with the best tool to prepare them for success in the nursing program, when sitting for the NCLEX-RN examination, and in their career.

**VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:**

Pursuant to State law, purchases and contracts for the use, purchase, delivery, movement or installation software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

**MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:**

The Office of MBE/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above request and, with no opportunity for further subcontracting for the acquisition of testing documents, is recommending a waiver of participation in compliance with the Board Approved Participation Plan.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and an amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7- 14 of the Illinois Public Community Act all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
