TERM:
The term of the agreement will commence on August 1, 2013 and end on July 31, 2016.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:
AT&T Corporation will provide a fully managed data circuit that will connect 4153 West 76th Street to the City Colleges of Chicago network and will provide up to 20Mbps of bandwidth for internet and enterprise services connectivity such as email, PeopleSoft applications, and file sharing.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:
This solution will provide the District with an OPT-E-MAN circuit that will connect 4153 West 76th Street, Chicago, Illinois location to the City Colleges of Chicago data network. This connectivity is identical to what is used at the satellite campuses and at 11 South LaSalle Street, and it is a reliable, secure and cost-effective solution to ensure that the District's different office locations may connect to the same network.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:
Pursuant to State law, purchases and contracts for the use, purchase, delivery, movement or installation of telecommunications and inter-connect equipment, software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of M/WBE Compliance has reviewed the above referenced agreement and has determined that due to the nature of the work (network services) there are no subcontracting opportunities and therefore recommends a waiver of the Board Approved Participation Plan.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability- Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
