Summary

This project would fund 2-4 students during summer 2013, fall 2013, and spring 2014 with an option to extend into summer 2014. These students would participate in two sets of quality control experiments related to the performance of new high-performance vacuum insulation panels. The students would learn different experimental and analytical skills, see how the knowledge that they gained throughout their coursework can be directly applied to current research, and have a chance to interact with the business community.
