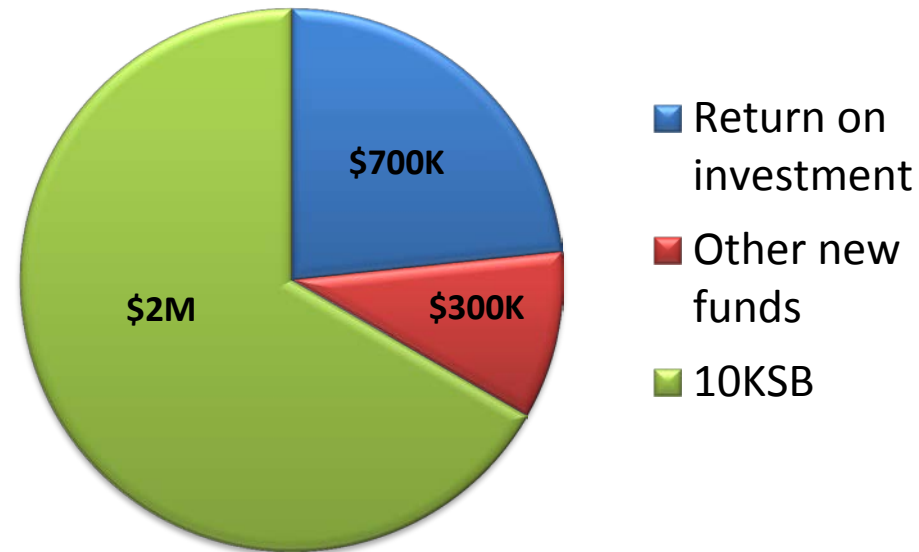
# Grant Process Improvements

- New centralized grant application process ensures alignment with CCC mission and goals
  - Funding Opportunity Program/Approval
  - Writing and Submission Review
  - Loading/Project Initiation Verification Process
- Compliance protocol and position created to ensure all CCC grants are meeting CCC and funder expectations
  - Closer coordination with Finance
  - Monitoring budgets
  - Timely and accurate reporting
- Created grants tracking summary
  - Track number of proposals submitted
  - Track and monitor grant conversion success rate
  - Track projects initiated, not just grant awards

# Activity

- FY13
  - \$48.5M in total active grants
    - \$25M in new dollars
    - \$14.4M in fiscal-year grants
    - \$8.5M in multi-year grants
  - 122 proposal submitted
  - 64 proposals funded
  - 79% of annual goal (\$32M)
  - \$16M in grant requests still pending

Foundation Assets grew \$3M in growth between FY11-FY13 is attributed to the following:



# Adding focus on giving

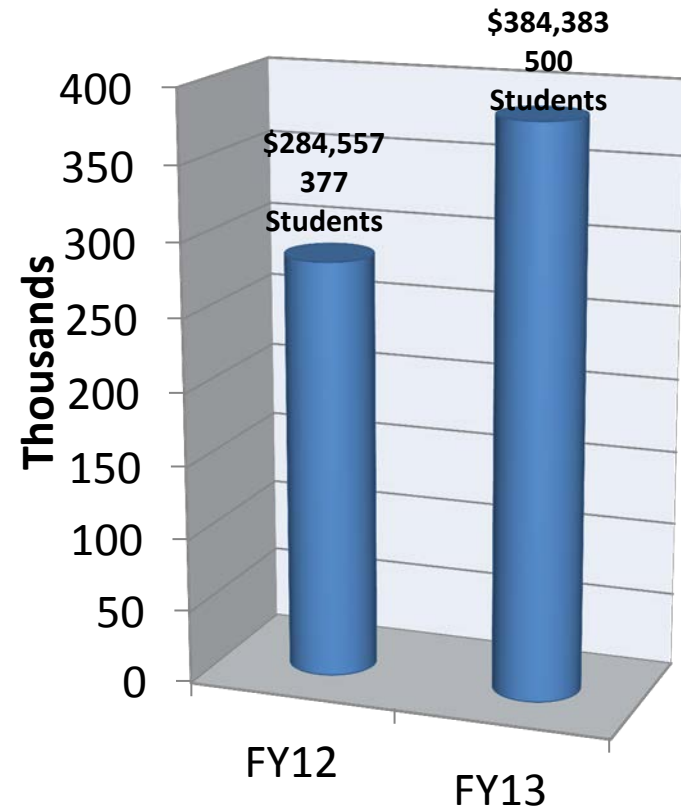
- CCC historically focused on grants
- Increased applications to private/corporate foundations
  - FY 11: 5 requests
  - FY 13: 30 requests (\$65K to date)
- Creating new position dedicated to corporate/individual giving
- Increased outreach to obtain new scholarship funds
  - FY 13: 7 scholarship funds established (\$70K)

# Reinvigorate CCC Foundation

- Foundation has had a small Board made up mostly of CCC employees
- Foundation has not sufficiently tapped into Chicago's civic and business communities to help fuel Reinvention
- Plan being developed for CCC trustees' involvement in CCC Foundation rethink
- Goal is to have reinvigorated foundation structure in place by end of FY14

# Scholarship Process Improvements

- Moved from paper to online scholarship application process
  - Comprehensive scholarships Web page – 1,300 students have viewed the page in the last 3 weeks
  - More objective
  - Clearly defined application timeframe
  - Eliminates excessive paperwork
- Consistent, district-wide scholarship windows
  - Spring 2014 –October 15th – December 1st
- Track # of students who have applied and been awarded



# CCC Alumni

- Definition
  - Completed a degree or certificate from any City College or predecessor institution
  - Earned at least 30 credits from City Colleges
- Alumni on record
  - 120,000 alumni records
  - 62,000 mailing addresses
  - 19,000 email addresses

# CCC Alumni Association Improvements

- Created infrastructure for alumni groups with nucleus of alumni at each of 7 colleges
- Established online member registration process (May)
  - Less than 50 registered members in 2011
  - 2013 – 200 registered members
  - 2014 goal – 2500 registered members
- Cultivate and reconnect in order to grow numbers
  - Sent first quarterly e-newsletters to 19K alumni (15% open rate)
    - Monthly e-blasts
- Partner with Workforce Development to promote CCC's Career Network (Spring 2013)
  - 304 alumni have been on the site
  - 106 alumni have uploaded resumes
- Sending CCC alumni mailing to 62K
- Partnered with Transfer Center for leadership conference for students and alumni
- Graduation week awareness: Distributed tote bags and association info
- Created on- and off-campus events to engage
