THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to execute an agreement with KONE, Inc. to perform elevator repairs and regulatory upgrade services District Wide commencing no sooner than April 3, 2014 and continuing through June 30, 2015, at a total cost not to exceed \$457,242.

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall commence no sooner than April 3, 2014 and continue through June 30, 2015.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

During Fall 2013, a District Wide Elevator Survey was conducted in order to identify, qualify and quantify safety, code, accessibility and sustainability issues that exist in the current elevators operating on a daily basis throughout the District. Code and/or Accessibility requirements such as infrared door detectors, keyed stop switches, emergency escape access door locks, pit stop switches and braille indicators in cabs and door jambs were found to be missing. Further sustainability and

longevity enhancements such as soft starters for elevator drive motors were also identified as highly desirable. This work will be scheduled to ensure that elevator service is maintained. KONE, Inc. submitted a proposal to install these items in each elevator that has been identified as deficient.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The proactive approach to this District Wide Elevator Up-Grade Effort stemmed from issues identified with the Elevators at Olive-Harvey College. The repair of these three elevators was originally budgeted at \$338,000. Given the nature of the improvements being proposed, a broader examination for similar deficiencies in all City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) Elevators, District Wide was in order. Thirty-two elevators and four escalators were inspected and evaluated at seven different facilities yielding a similar list of code violations, safety deficiencies and accessibility exposures. This effort will demonstrate CCC's commitment to the safe, code compliant and accessible operation of this equipment for daily student and staff use.
