# OLIVE-HARVEY COLLEGE ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION OF EXISTING BUILDINGS BRANDENBURG INDUSTRIAL SERVICE COMPANY OLIVE-HARVEY COLLEGE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND PROCUREMENT SERVICES

#### THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to execute an agreement with Brandenburg Industrial Service Company to provide abatement, demolition and excavation of 9 existing buildings, which includes the preparation of plans and specifications to be utilized for estimating and construction/demolition at a total cost not to exceed \$562,127.50.

**VENDOR:** Brandenburg Industrial Service Company

#### TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence no sooner than December 11, 2014 and continue through December 31, 2015.

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Through a previous agreement approved by the Board which began on April 4, 2013, Brandenburg Industrial Service Company (Brandenburg) has provided abatement, demolition and excavation of 9 temporary 1-story buildings at Olive-Harvey College, which included soil excavation, backfill and site preparation as per the technical drawings and specification documents prepared by Milhouse Engineering & Consultants, Inc., and any other site work required to properly execute this project.

This new agreement with Brandenburg is necessary due to additional design criteria mandated by the Illinois Capital Development Board and the Architect of Record which requires the removal of unexpectedly large quantities of soil from the site. This unforeseen mandate will require increasing volumes of replacement structural backfill to restore the strength of the surrounding earth to ensure a sturdy foundation at an additional cost of \$562,127.50.

#### BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The project will facilitate the demolition of extremely outdated structures that were initially anticipated to provide temporary additional space to support the programmatic growth of Olive-Harvey College. These structures can no longer provide useful learning environments that meet the needs of the evolving teaching methods employed at Olive-Harvey. This project will also provide the land on which to build the new transportation, distribution and logistics facility.

# **VENDOR SELCTION CRITERIA:**

The contract being utilized as part of the joint purchasing agreement has been advertised and awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures of the City of Chicago, a sister agency to CCC, under contract #26167, specification 101334 to demolition and excavation services. Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and services procured from another governmental entity are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.
