1.	DO	Articulation	In 2010, CCC entered into a partnership with CPS to increase CPS student success beyond high school. Per the agreement, students would take articulated courses related to Emergency Medical Technician-Basic training and CPS would be responsible for providing students training in the Chicago Police and Firefighter Academy program. The agreement required renewal after the first three-year term by Academic Affairs but was allowed to expire while still allowing students to participate in the articulation program. Those students will not be given proper credit without an executed agreement so the department is now seeking to backdate the agreement.	10/1/12- 7/1/14

4.	MX	Rush University Medical Center MOU	The facility will provide, at no cost, laboratory space for 30 students enrolled in Biology 130, Human Cadaver Anatomy class. This will provide students with the perspective of dissecting human specimens in a real-life medical setting while becoming familiar with the location, texture and general appearance of human tissue.	9/1/14- 7/31/16
